

Part I


What is the Montessori Triangle?

The Montessori Learning Triangle represents the three components that provide strength and support to uphold and provide the foundation for the Montessori Philosophy.




Part 2

Part 3

How Do We Envision Engaging Families Using the Strength of Connections in the Triangle?

We invite you to *Be a Part of Every Angle*:

- **Support the teacher's connection with the child, and strengthen the bond between the school culture and the classroom culture by embracing Montessori Parenting.**
- **Support the child's connection with the environment, and strengthen the bond between the classroom and the community by modeling life-long learning.**
- **Support the environment's connection to the teacher, and strengthen the bond by connecting the community to the school by spreading Montessori to others.**

**How do Families Help Connect The Classes to our School at IMS?
By supporting the philosophy of our school and culture of the class
while embracing a Montessori Parenting Approach.**

Strong parenting connects our classes and school. Strength in parenting is found in the process of promoting and supporting the physical, emotional, social, and intellectual development of a child. We accomplish this together by promoting any of these developmental areas while present in the classroom, as their family member, and as a life-long learner.

**How Do Families Help Connect Class and Community at IMS?
By supporting student lifelong learning and by modeling and
supporting their own personal lifelong learning.**

Connecting our classes to our surrounding local community contributes to the betterment of student learning and family member's personal growth in character strength. When children see their family want to learn- they too want to be a part of it. This mindset of learning is then transferred into the classroom culture. Family members model for students that learning never ends. Being involved in the community and learning through volunteerism, service or simply participating in the school's parent education is the perfect way to have a child ask, "What did you learn today?"

**How Do Families Help Connect the Community and School at IMS?
By supporting the school in volunteering and collaborating with the
community to extend our Montessori Philosophy to others.**

Volunteering and collaborating with the community supports the connection between the school and the community. The Montessori philosophy supports the child interacting with the school and community using their skills of independence. Taking them out into the community to work independently through volunteering or service allows them to mirror the work they do at the school, and introduces them to the lessons learned through community participation. Families learning from student's volunteering together, as the child is able to show skills of independence they have mastered. This is a child's time to shine!

How do you know if an IMS volunteer opportunity is a good fit for me?

Here is how we define it...

How Long:

Brief Commitment- 2 Hours or less

Moderate Commitment- can stretch over a few days

Long-Term Commitment- Can stretch over 1 week or more

Near or Far:

Near- Must Be on site or at event to carry out volunteer work.

Far- Volunteer work is done completely off-site
